There are 38 camp slots that are filled on a first come – first served basis.
- The following criteria will be considered in determining 4-H camp scholarship recipients:
 - Participation in 4-H activities (in-school and out-of-school)
 - Financial need/family situation
 - Priority will be given to first time 4-H campers & scholarship applicants
- This application will be reviewed by the Extension staff only and then destroyed to maintain your privacy.
- All applicants will be notified via phone and/or email if they did or did not receive a scholarship by Friday, March 29th, 2025. If you submit a scholarship after March 29th, you will be notified of your scholarship award status as soon as your application is reviewed.
